We acknowledge reception of your correspondence dated of June 22nd, 2009 concerning the above noted project.

Eolectric is closely following the evolution of the Ministry of Energy and Infrastructure's Green Energy and Economy Act and reviewing the MOE draft guidelines with respect to setbacks and the implications these will have on the Honeywood project. This being said, the project is being reviewed with consideration to the changes in the aforementioned guidelines, and will only be in a position to complete its update on the outstanding studies once these new guidelines are finalized.
